I received a call from a committee that organizes August annual conference requesting me if I could assist with One tonne of maize. This year people did not harvest adequate crops because of inadequate rainfall. After deep thinking and praying on how best I could raise a tonne of maize , I bought 4x20 Litres of diesel and asked some of fellow brothers with grinding mills to use my fuel. The idea was well accepted. This initiative created an opportunity for me to visit my grinding mill and also talk to pastor Jairus about his ministry.

He said a lot had happened and God demonstrated His power over sicknesses, illnesses and evil spirits. I was so attentive as he narrated a series of stories. One of the narratives was of a widow whose son would now and again was on bed because of illness. As a concerned mother she deeded her best taking her child to the clinics and hospitals for treatment but all was in vain. Some of her neighbors advised her to take the child to some prophetic Churches, of which she did. Some prophets charged her several goats and others charged cows. She did her best in paying because all she wanted was to see her child get well. Unfortunately the boy's illness continued.

Some people in the neighborhood accused her of little faith, others accused her of sin in her life. Many people spoke different things against her. She was confused and lost peace of mind until one lovely Christian lady referred her to pastor Jairus. When she came and unpacked what she went through and all losses she met, pastor Jairus was so moved in spirit and asked to pray for the child for two weeks.

The child's mother couldn't believe it but the child was busy playing with other children. She asked how many cows she could pay for the healing of her child.
